

Viterra Carbon Credit Program

Application Instructions

Accurately completing Viterra's Carbon Credit application form helps to ensure that your application can be processed as quickly as possible. The following instructions are intended to help guide you through the various sections of the application form.

Land Details

This area provides us with an overall summary of the land types on your farm. Complete this section as accurately as you can. Leave any sections blank that are not applicable.

Seeding Equipment Details

Please provide the following equipment details for all seeding equipment used on your farm. If more than one seeder was used please complete the information requested on a separate page.

- Seeding Equipment Make/Model: List the name of the seeding equipment.
- Row Spacing: List the row spacing measurement of the seeder in "inches" (i.e. 9, 10, 12 inches, etc.).
- Opener Type: Provide a description of the opener type (i.e. disc, knife, side-band, paired row, etc.).
- Opener Width: List the width of the opener in "inches". If you are unsure, use a measuring tape to measure the opener width at the widest part that is in the ground.
- Type of Packing: Provide a description of the type of packing used.
- Packing Width (optional): List the width of the packing wheel.

Fertilizer Application Details

Describe when, how and what type of fertilizer is applied on your farm. Below are a few common examples:

One pass systems:

- Side-banded at seeding.
- Mid-row banded at seeding.
- Seed-placed at seeding.

Two pass systems:

- Fall banding (separate from seeding). Please note the row spacing and opener width of the banding tool.
- Spring banding (separate from seeding). Please note the row spacing and opener width of the banding tool.
- Broadcast (spread on the surface).
- Dribble-banded liquid fertilizer.

Land Details Section

- Legal Land Description: These must be listed by individual Quarter Sections. Even if you farm a half-section, the land details must be listed for each Quarter.
- Land Title holder: List the name(s) of the current land title holder(s) for leased land. Corporate farms should consider owned land listed under individual names as leased land.
- Calendar years leased: Please list the calendar years that the land was leased. This should be shown as either individual years. For example: 2002 or a range of years (i.e. 2002-2011).
- Total No. of Acres Farmed: This is the area of the land farmed on this quarter including summerfallow, pasture, etc.
- No Till: This section collects information on how many acres qualify as No Till for specific years.
 - No. of acres farmed: The area seeded, using No Till, on this quarter for each year. Perennial forages (hay, pasture) and chemfallow are not eligible and should not be included.
 - Calendar years farmed: Please list the calendar years that the land was cropped. This should be shown as either individual years (i.e. 2002 or a range of years (i.e. 2002-2011).
- Reduced Till: This section collects information on how many acres qualify as Reduced Till for specific years.
 - No. of acres farmed: The number of acres seeded using Reduced Till on this quarter for each year. Perennial forages (hay, pasture) and chemfallow are not eligible and should not be included.
 - Calendar years farmed: Please list the calendar years that the land was cropped. This should be shown as either individual years (i.e. 2002 or a range of years (i.e. 2002-2011).
