Declaration

1. Viterra can issue a Recipient Created Tax Invoice (RCTI) for supplies delivered under this registration card.
2. You will not issue tax invoices for supplies delivered under this registration card.
3. You will notify Viterra if you cease to be registered for GST.
4. Viterra is registered for GST and it will notify you if it ceases to be registered or if it ceases to satisfy any of the requirements for issuing an RCTI. Viterra will not issue an RCTI after it ceases to be eligible to do so.
5. You will reimburse Viterra for any amount incorrectly paid to you as GST.

Payment Instruction by Direct Credit

Payment will be deemed to have been made when Viterra has instructed its banker to credit your nominated account via electronic funds transfer (EFT). Viterra does not accept any responsibility for delays in payment or errors outside the reasonable control of Viterra including but not limited to delays or errors caused by the banking system or the payment instruction notified. Viterra reserves the right to suspend or terminate its direct credit system for payments at any time and may make its payments by cheque or in any other manner that may be determined. You agree to pay Viterra on demand any payments credited to your account in error and Viterra reserves the right to set off the amount of such overpayment against any future payment owing to you by Viterra.

All financial institutional charges and government taxes associated with the receipt by you of payments to your nominated account shall be borne by you.

Who are we?

We are Viterra Ltd ABN 59 084 962 130, and we are engaged in the bulk handling and marketing of commodities. When we refer to "we" or "us" in this statement it is meant to include our agents and consultants.

Our commitment to privacy

Viterra is committed to the responsible use of information collected by us. We will only use the information in the manner indicated to you at the time of collection or as you may authorise and where that use provides for disclosure to third parties we will ensure so far as possible that the use is restricted to the disclosed or authorised purposes and that the information is stored in a secure environment. Nothing in this Statement should be read as limiting or restricting our rights as set out in the Privacy Act (Cwlth) as amended from time to time.

What we collect

Viterra collects information through its registration form falling into two broad categories: payment details and contact details.

What if you choose not to supply the information?

The collection of the information is necessary to ensure that we accurately record your deliveries to our storage system and that you get timely payment for your deliveries.

How do we use the information?

The payment details (bank accounts, tax details, payment splits) will only be for the following purposes:

- To make payment to you for the purchase of commodities;
- To invoice you for the supply of services;
- To make mandatory returns to the Australian Tax Office and other government bodies as required by law;
- For any other purpose you may authorise.

We will use the contact details to ensure that your deliveries to the Viterra system are recognised and allocated to the correct financial arrangement and to facilitate payments to you for commodities purchased by us. We may refer your contact details to parties that have purchased your commodity.

We may use the contact details for internal business applications such as organising on-farm pick ups and linking the information to delivery data on the *ezigrain* web site.

We may also use this information for stakeholder communications, for the establishment of your records on the national grower register, to ascertain grain paths and for other statistical analysis. You will be given the opportunity to withdraw your consent to the use or disclosure of the information for sales and marketing purposes, by contacting the Privacy Officer (see below).

Access and correction

You have the right to a copy of the payment details and the contract details held on our records. You may correct those details at any time by contacting the Viterra Service Centre (phone: 1800 018 205) or such other contact as we may nominate.
