**Viterra constructs new weighbridge at Loxton site**

Viterra is constructing a second weighbridge at its Loxton receival site to ensure faster turnaround times during the harvest period. The company is investing more than \$400,000 in the new weighbridge and associated road works.

Dean McQueen, Executive Manager Grain, said the additional weighbridge would assist with traffic efficiency through the site and reduce the volume of traffic around the classification office and amenities buildings.

“The need for a second weighbridge was highlighted during the Post Harvest Review consultation process from growers in the area.

“Loxton is a strategic site and this additional weighbridge will assist with eliminating bottlenecks during the busy harvest period,” he said.

The new weighbridge will be a state-of-the-art electronic bridge, which streamlines delivery or outturn processes using barcode scanners to update the gross and tare details.

“Across the state, we will be investing an additional \$2.4 million in upgrading and automating weighbridges at a number of strategic sites,” Mr McQueen said.

Viterra has engaged local contractors to undertake the earthworks. Construction will commence late August and be finished before harvest.

Since 2009, Viterra has invested more than \$40 million in storage, transport, logistics, people and port terminal infrastructure for the benefit of Australian growers, marketers and international customers.

Viterra has committed to developing a five year capital expenditure plan, which will strategically address elevation capacity, amenities, road works and safety.
